- Seamless Day update – new ECE at the head of the program as of today
- Student learning surveys are out right now – everyone encouraged to participate, including parents
- Gym hallway, library, office currently being painted
- School fees – changed last year and will stay the same this coming school year
- Affordability grant – money focused on breakfast program offered to kids; new Food Grant coming next year to hopefully continue to support nutrition for kids at school
- Candy Bones Theatre coming to school for May 11
- Work BC Find Your Fit career exhibition hosted in school gym May 10
