Application Process

Applications are invited from all interested students. Successful applicants, meeting the established criteria will be accepted:

- Grade 3: must currently be on a Minor Hockey Team.
- Grade 4-7: not required to be on a Minor Hockey Team, should have experience skating.
- Must be in good standing both academically and behaviourally.

We will be offering HCSA on Tuesdays and Thursdays for our Hawks team and Wednesdays and Fridays for our Nights team beginning in mid September and ending in March prior to Spring Break. A Hockey Academy jersey will also be included for those students that register and pay before the end of June.

Please note that incomplete applications will not be considered. Students must maintain good standing of coursework and classroom/playground behaviour. Failure to do so may result in removal from the program.

Should you be accepted into the program, the payment schedule is as follows:

- Tuition Fee: \$325.00 per year (discounts may be applicable when more than one child per family is enrolled in the program.)
